come I, S. J. Bouthit Master in and for the
County aforesaid, send Greeting: Whereas
Moses W. Bridges in his own right and
as administrator of the estate of Thomas
Bridges, deceased, on or about the 15th
day of November in the year of our Lord
eighteen hundred and eighty two exhibited
his complaint in the Court of Common
Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against
Eliza Ann Bridges, Mary S. McDaniel and
others, demanding judgment in relation
to the Real Estate herein after mentioned
