B. Irvine, Beginning at a stone 8x on the Hwy. Clark road and running N. 34° 47' 18.90 to a stake (old stump) thence W. 44° 47' 27.79 to a stone 8x at the end of the next Road, thence with said road N. 85° E. to the beginning. Containing Twenty four and one-half Acres more or less, and designated by a post of the same marked Lot No. 6.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Privileges and appurtenances to the said premises belonging and incident thereto. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Abraham Green his heirs and assigns forever.
