hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining:
To Have And To Hold, all and singular the said premises
before mentioned unto the said J.W.Burgess his Heirs
and Assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself &
successors in office to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said
J.W.Burgess, his Heirs and Assigns, against itself
and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully
claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof
