Five Hundred Dollars to me paid by Isaac Kelly in  
the State aforesaid, Greenville County have granted, bar-  
gained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release, unto the said Isaac Kelly  
all that piece parcel or tract of land situate in the  
State and County aforesaid twelve miles North of  
Greenville to w.s. on the Cuncombe Road beginning at  
the crossing of the Cuncombe and miles Roads and running  
thence N 64° 44' W 21.66 ch to a stake in the road thence N 38° 46'  
W. ch, to a stake in road, thence S 55° 46' W 20.13 ch to a stone  
thence S 17° 16' E 585 ch to a post oak, thence S 19. W 21.16 ch to a red  
oak (down an a spring) thence down and with the meanderings  
of the spring branch about 8.20 E. 8.45 ch to a mulberry thence  
S 79° E. 20.20 ch to a stake on the Cuncombe Road thence N 22°  
E. 23.53 ch along the Cuncombe Road to the Beginning corner  
containing Seventy Eight acres more or less, adjoining  
land of H. H. Barnett Wesley & others and known  
as the Tarpin place together with all and singular the  
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold, all and singular the said premises
