

Whereas by section 100 of an act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina entitled "An act to reduce an act and parts of acts providing for the assessment and taxation of property unto one act and to amend the same" Approved March 19th, 1874, it is provided that each County Auditor in this State shall annually cause the list of delinquent lands in the County to be published once for two weeks, between the 16th of February and the second Monday in March following, in one newspaper, and no more, published in his County, and no paper be published, in said County, than in some newspaper having the most general circulation in said County, to which list there shall be attached a notice in the following form to wit: Notice is hereby given that the whole of the several parcels, lots and parts of lots of real estate described in the preceding list, or so much thereof as will be necessary to pay the taxes, penalties and assessments charged thereon, will be sold by the Treasurer of Greenville County, South Carolina, at his Office in said County on the second Monday of March A.D. 1878, unless said taxes, assessments and penalties be paid before that time; and a said sale will be continued from day to day until all of said parcels, lots and parts of lots of real estate shall be sold or offered for sale; And whereas there appears on the Tax Duplicate of Greenville County for the year 1874, ex-Tenant Estate, Consisting of Two acres of land assessed in the name of George Horsch and same at One hundred Dollars, the taxes, assessments and penalties charged thereon amounting to six ³⁴⁵/₁₀₀ dollars. And whereas the above named George Horsch neglected to pay to the County Treasurer of Greenville County the above taxes, assessments and penalties as prescribed by law; And whereas, in accordance with the provisions of an act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina entitled to raise supplies and make appropriations for the fiscal year commencing Jan 1st 1875, approved March 19th 1874 the Comptroller General County Auditor of Greenville County pursuant thereto, advised the above described property in the name of George Horsch, as delinquent land to be sold by the County Treasurer of Greenville County on that day. And whereas the said George Horsch failing to pay the amount of six ³⁴⁵/₁₀₀ dollars.

property, for the least quantity thereof, to wit ^{one thousand eight} of said his acre of land, he became the purchaser, and having paid the said amount unto the County Treasury a certificate of purchase for the quantity so sold was given to him accordingly. And whereas, by section 116 of the act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina first above mentioned, it is provided that, after the lapse of nine days from the time of any delinquent land sale, if any purchaser of any real estate at such sale, or his legal representative, shall present to the Auditor of the County in which such sale was made a certificate of purchase of the whole of any tract or lot of real estate sold at such sale, or in case of the sale of part of a tract or lot offered at such sale, present to said Auditor the certificate of sale and the survey and plan of the quantity purchased, made by the Surveyor as required by this act, and the taxes and assessments levied on the real estate described in such certificate, or certificate and plan, shall be honored for payment as that the same is not again delinquent, said Auditor shall upon payment to him of two dollars as his compensation therefor, make and deliver to such purchaser, his heirs or assigns, as the case may be, a deed of conveyance for the real estate so sold as aforesaid. And whereas, the period of ninety one days having elapsed since the sale as held as aforesaid, the said G. Horsch has presented his said certificate of purchase to the County Auditor of Greenville County, and the taxes and assessments levied on the said estate described therein have been so far paid, as that the same is not again delinquent, now therefore I, Andrew R. Smith, County Auditor of the County of Greenville in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of the sum of two Dollars good and lawful money of the United States to me in hand paid by the said G. Horsch, here granted, bargained, sold and released ^{to} by this present or grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. Horsch, all that piece or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State of South Carolina, just outside the City limits, for a further description see plan of survey adjoining lands of Henry Brown and a ^E lot with same, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise in connection therewith.
