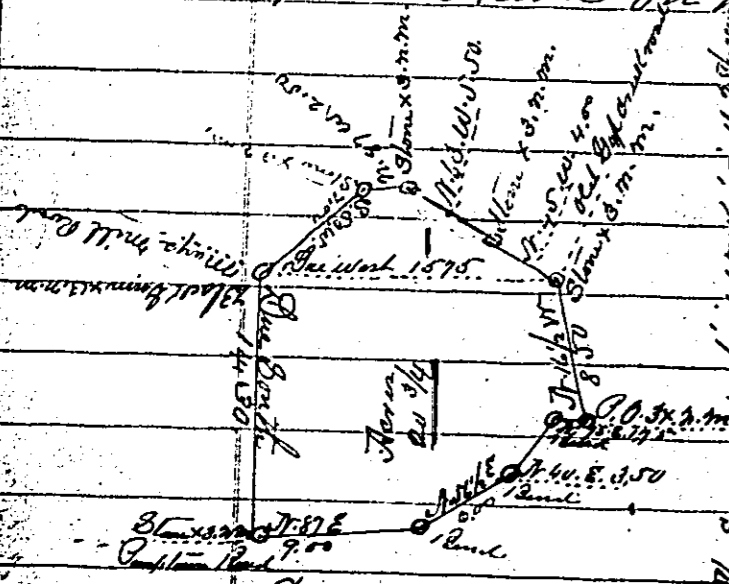


Jardner Gibbon State of South Carolina

Know all men by these presents  
that I Jardner Gibbon of the said State and County  
in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and twenty Six  
Dollars and 25 cts. to me in hand paid by Job Langford  
of the State and County above mentioned Have  
granted, sold, conveyed, released and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Job Langford all that piece parcel or tract of land sit-  
uate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid  
on the North side of the Pumptown Town Road near  
Mantles between the old Gap Creek Road and Middle Saluda  
River containing seven by five and one fourth  
acres be that same more or less Beginning at a  
P. O. x 3 m. in the fork of old Gap Creek and Pumptown Town Roads  
at an angle of 10 & 1/2 North and W. E. 1/2 E. 1/2 S. 1/2  
116 1/2 W. 8, 3/4 and 1/2 old Gap Creek road to Stone  
x 3 m. thence N. 45 W. 4.50 to stone x 3 m. thence N. 63 W. 5.50 to  
stone x 3 m. thence N. 87 W. 2.50 to stone x 3 m. thence  
S. 50 W. 7.00 to Black Run x 3 m. (The last four corners  
are in and near a road leading to Major Mills) thence due South  
14.00 to stone x 3 m. on the line of W. D. Keith's land  
in the Pumptown Town road thence N. 87 E. 9.00  
to Bend in said road thence N. 56 E. 6.00 to Bend in  
said road thence N. 40 E. 3.50 to Bend in said road  
thence N. 75 E. 1.75 to the beginning P. O. corner the  
four last corners are on the line of said Keith's land  
According to the following copy of a survey made by  
J. M. Hunt on the 24th day of February 1883

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs

defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Job Langford his heirs and assigns against my  
self and my heirs and every other person whom

lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

and in the One hundred and Seventh year of the  
Independence of the United States of America
