<u>William May</u>	<u>Whereas by Section 100 of</u>
	<u>the Act of the General Assembly of the State of South</u>
	<u>Carolina, entitled An Act to Repeal all acts and</u>
	<u>parts of acts, providing for the assessment and</u>
	<u>valuation of property with one act and to amend the</u>
	<u>same approved March 19 1874, it is provided, that</u>
	<u>such Act, as Auditor in this State shall annually</u>
	<u>name the list of delinquent lands in the County to be</u>
	<u>published weekly for two weeks between the 16th</u>
	<u>of February and the second 21st day in March following</u>
	<u>in one newspaper and no more published in the</u>
	<u>County and if no paper be established in said County</u>
	<u>then in some newspaper having the most general</u>
	<u>Circulation in said County to which list there shall</u>
	<u>be attached a notice in the following form to wit:</u>
	<u>Whereas, hereby you are that the whole of the several</u>
	<u>parcels and parts of lots of real estate described</u>
	<u>in the preceding list or so much thereof as</u>
	<u>will be necessary to pay the taxes, penalties and</u>
	<u>assessments charged thereon will be sold by the</u>
	<u>Auditor of Dixieville County Booth Education</u>
	<u>and Office in said County on the First Monday</u>
	<u>in February A.D. 1883, under said Tax & Impost</u>
	<u>and Penalties be paid before that time and said</u>
	<u>Sale will be continued from day to day until</u>
	<u>all of said parcels lots and parts of lots of</u>
	<u>real estate shall be sold or offered for sale.</u>
	<u>And Whereas there appears in the Tax & Impost</u>
	<u>of Dixieville County for the year 1882, certain</u>
	<u>real estate consisting of one lot and building</u>
	<u>assessed in the name of Dennis L. Taylor and</u>
	<u>land at Dixie Valley the sum amounting</u>
	<u>and Penalties charged thereon amounting to four</u>
	<u>dollars.</u>
	<u>And Whereas the above named Dennis L. Taylor</u>
	<u>neglected to pay to the County Treasurer</u>
	<u>of Dixieville County the above sum and</u>
	<u>penalties and Penalties as prescribed by law.</u>
	<u>And Whereas an act was made with the approv-</u>
	<u>al of an Act of the General Assembly of</u>

the State of South Carolina entitled an Act to
name Delinquent and make assessments for the year
beginning Nov 1st 1883 approved Oct 24 1878
The County Auditor of Dixieville County
whereas there is a tract of land above described lying
in the name of Dennis L. Taylor as delinquent
Land to be sold by my County Treasurer of Dixie-
ville County on that day
And Whereas at a Sale so held by the County
Treasurer of Dixieville County on that day shall
and shall offering to pay the amount of the tax
assessment and penalties charged on the above
described property in the light quantity thereof to wit
Upon learning of the lot to be sold William W.
Bearne the Surveyor and Taxer of said County
and Auditor of the County Treasury a certificate of
purchase for the quantity so sold was given
to him accordingly
And Whereas by Section 16 of the Act of the
General Assembly of the State of South Carolina
last above mentioned it is provided that after
the last of November one day from the time of
any delinquent land sale of any property
any real estate at such sale or his legal referee
shall present to the Auditor of the County
in which such sale was made a certificate of
purchase of the whole of any tract or lot of
real estate sold at such sale or in case of the
Sale of part of a tract or lot offered at such
sale present to said Auditor the Certificate of
Sale and the Survey and Plot of the quantity
purchased made by the Surveyor as required
by this Act and the tax and assessment levied
over the real estate described in such Certificate
or Certificate and that shall have been so far
paid as that the same is not again delinquent
said Auditor shall upon payment to him of two
dollars as his compensation therefor make and
deliver to such purchaser his Deed or assign
or the same may be a Deed of Conveyance
the real estate so sold as aforesaid.
