 leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
 and release unto the said J. H. Foster his heirs and
 assigns forever all that piece, share or tract of land
 situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and
 State aforesaid South Carolina adjoining lands of Mr.
 A. J. Harris, Mrs. Elizabeth Berry and others and bound-
 ed as follows to wit. Beginning at a stake 3x3 in the
 road leading from the Harris bridge road to the white
