

State of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina and in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars and one hundred and twenty five dollars paid by the said Richard Harrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released; and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Richard Harrison all our rights, title and interest the same being two individual tracts in that parish, share and tract of land containing two hundred and thirty six acres more or less, situate, lying and being in Greenville Town ship in the County and State aforesaid out of Crispel Creek of Rudy River, and adjoining lands of N. W. 1/4 of S. E. Harrison and others, and bounded by the following miles and bounds westerly beginning at a Red Oak 3x out at road and running thence S 41 E 54, 00 to a stone 3x on the Jenkins Bridge Road, thence along said road as a line about 400 to stone 3x, thence S 61 W 82, 00 to a stake 3x in the mouth of a branch in Crispel Creek, thence down said branch as a line to a sycamore 3x at the foot thereof S 14 E 64, 00 across the Creek to the beginning, also all our rights title and interest in one other tract containing Thirty four acres, more or less, lying on Rudy River below the mouth of Crispel Creek, beginning at a sycamore 3x on the River, and running thence S 50 E 13, 00 to a stone 3x thence S 50 E 16, 35 to a Red Elm 3x on the River, thence down the River as a line to the beginning, said land being a part of the tract now 2x of the lands of the Estate of John H. Harrison deceased.
