of Georgia, for and in consideration of the sum
of One thousand and eighty seven and 5/100
(\$87.50) Dollars to and in hand paid at and
before the sealing of these presents by Muster
Lake of the County of Greenville, in the State
of Georgia, (the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold
and released, and by these presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto
the said Muster Lake, all those certain
pieces, parcels and lots of land situate
lying and being in the County of Greenville
in the State of Georgia, about two and one
half miles from Greenville City (West) on and
near the Piedmont and the Atlanta and Charlotte
Air Line Rail Road and known and repre-
sented as Lot No. 6 containing two acres to 4
containing five and six tenths of an acre
and No. 2 containing three and six tenths
acres and more fully described by metes
and bounds in a plat of the said here to
attached, by H. P. Johnson J.D. of the date of
March 28 1883 being parcels of the same tract
of land formerly owned Col. David Hoke
reserving the right of way for a Rail way
together with all and singular the rights
tenements, Hereditaments and appurte-
nances to the said premises, belong-
ing, or in anywise incident or apper-

taining, do now and to have, all and sin-
gular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said Muster Lake his heirs and as-
signs forever, And will do hereby bind our
selves and our heirs, executors and admin-
istrators, to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said premises unto the said
Muster Lake and his heirs and assigns, a-
gainst us and our heirs, and all other per-
sons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or
any part thereof
