	50	New Thomas James Cox late of Small Township, Greenville County and who deceased, departed this life intestate and was intestate about the 23 <sup>rd</sup> day of September 1803, leaved and possessed of a certain tract of land containing about two hundred and forty-eight acres and fourth a crop which has ever since remained in the possession of his widow Sarah Cox. And whereas the said James Cox, deceased, left nothing herein as his heirs at law and distribution was made to Sarah Cox, and his few sons Samuel H. Cox, James H. Cox, Matthew S. Cox, William E. Cox and Benjamin P. Cox (who departed this life inter- tate and survived on the 27 <sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1880 all of whom are above the age of twenty-one years and whereas no partition or division of said Real Estate has ever been had and being desirous to have the same without recourse to the Courts And whereas the said Real Estate was surveyed at the request and by the consent of all parties in interest on 3 <sup>rd</sup> day of March 1882 by James E. Nichols 10.8 and by him cut into six different tracts as follows: tract, Tract No. 1 containing fifty acres, Tract No. 2 containing forty-nine acres Tract No. 3, containing forty-two and three quar- ters acres, Tract No. 4 containing forty-two and one half acres, Tract No. 5 containing forty-one acre and Tract No. 6 containing twenty-three acres each tract having the metes and bounds, courses and distances as shown by the plats of said survey more or less No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, No. 5 and No. 6, - No. 1 of which is fully attached; And whereas by consent of all parties in interest Tract No. 1 was assigned to Sarah Cox, Tract No. 2 was assigned to Matthew S. Cox Tract No. 3, was assigned to Samuel M. Cox, Tract No. 4 was assigned William E. Cox, Tract No. 5 was assigned to James H. Cox, and Tract No. 6 to Ben- jamin P. Cox now deceased and each tract unto the

scoring of the tract assigned to him; And whereas  
said Sarah Cox, Samuel M. Cox, Matthew S. Cox, William  
E. Cox and James H. Cox are devisees of said property each  
other in order to perfect their title; Now know ye  
that we Samuel M. Cox, James H. Cox, Matthew S. Cox  
and William E. Cox for and in consideration that  
the said Sarah Cox dies this day granted, bargained  
grimed sold and released, to us respectively all  
her right title and interest in and to the tracts  
of land assigned to us respectively, as above set  
forth and in the further consideration of the sum  
of five dollars to us paid by the said Sarah Cox  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
granted, bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said Sarah Cox all our right title and inter-  
est in and to a certain lot or parcel of land belong-  
ing to the estate of James Cox deceased situated in Greenville  
County and State aforesaid on both sides of the Ruby  
Creek or Reedy River, and known as Tract No. 1 in the  
James Cox Deed from Survey March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1882, containing  
fifty acres more or less, having the following metes  
and bounds, Courses and distances to wit, begin-  
ning at a stone 3x and Red oak 3x and running thence  
S. 28° W. 33.28 to a stone 3x, thence S. 5° E. 12.40 to a stone  
thence N. 47° E. 27.20 to a stone 3x, thence N. 18° E. 81.9.09  
to a stone 3x, thence N. 60° E. 21.19 to the beginning cor-  
ner as per plat hereunto attached, together with all  
and singular the rights, members, undivided interests  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
to us or anyone in extent or appertaining.  
We have and to hold all and singular the said  
premises before mentioned unto the said Sarah  
Cox her heirs and assigns forever, And we do bind  
by these our selves our heirs executors and admiri-  
cators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said Sarah  
Cox, her heirs and assigns against us and  
our heirs and every other person or persons whom  
soever lawfully claiming as to claim the same  
or any part thereof witness our hands and  
seals this the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of
