O. 3x, S. 50 E. 75 to P. O. 3x, S. 62 E. 16.50 to P. O. 3x, S. 85 E. 30.49 to Rock, then N. 17 W. 30.50 to stake in branch, then down the said branch to the beginning, the branch to be the line, containing Ninety six acres.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said

Robert Ward his Heirs and Assigns forever.

O. 3x, S. 85 E. 30.49 to Rock, then N. 17 W. 30.50 to stake in Branch, then down the said Branch to the beginning, the Branch to be the line, containing Ninety-six acres.
