KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Dollars, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Lemona Griffin (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lemona Griffin all that lot or parcel of land containing two and one fourth acres more or less situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about four miles west of Greenville Court House on the kind and good road adjoining lands of William S. Williams, said Griffin and myself and having the following courses and distances viz: Beginning at a stake on the west side in a road and running thence N 62 E with road 1/2 mile to a red oak 5' and in the back of the road N 17 E 960 to a stone 3 1/2 miles to a white oak line thence with said road S 81 E 530 to a stone 3 1/2 miles to a white oak line thence S 81 E 530 to the beginning corner in the road the same being a part of the land conveyed to me by S.
