Verner, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty (\$1,150.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Pettion, Brown & Investment Company, a corporation created by and under the law of the State of South Carolina, whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Pettion, Brown & Investment Company, a corporation created by and under the law of the State of South Carolina, "All that certain lot or parcel of land situate within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing one eighth of one acre, more or less, bounded on the North by Sullivan Street, East by William Turner, South by J. H.
