and before the sealing of these presents by William H. Huff of said State and County  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,  
release unto the said William H. Huff, all of that piece parcel or tract  
of land situate lying and being in said State and County  
about one and one half miles from the Court House, known  
as lot number one of Marshall's Addition to the City of Greenville  
according to map prepared by J. P. Burdett, Surveyor, on the  
day of December A.D. 1897, and filed in the office of the Register  
of Deeds for said County and State in Book  
of Deeds, at page 658, said lot number one being de-  
scribed as follows: to wit, beginning at a point 34' in the middle  
of the creek above the stone bridge where Highland Avenue  
crosses said creek, thence up said creek, the middle of  
creek being the line between said lot number and  
Mrs Nancy Johnson's land, to a point 34' in the middle of said  
creek at the corner of the Greenvilleertilizer Company's land,  
N 46° W 200 feet (the first portion of this course following the line  
ditch) to a point 34', thence S 31 1/4 W 781 feet to a point on Highland  
Avenue, at corner of Lot No. 2, thence along said Highland Avenue  
S 54 34' E 121 feet to the beginning point, containing three
