Baldwin (my father) and being land conveyed to said C. L. Baldwin by David Adams.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said John E. Baldwin, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself John E. Baldwin, Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said John E. Baldwin, his
