Clark, of Greenville, County, all that certain tract of land lying and being in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, upon the Road from the Rudy Fork Creek, of Little Elbow and having the following lines, poles and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 3 paces on the Road from a ridge and running thence N. 10° E. 25.10 to a stone 3 paces on the branch thereof of the branch and a line 11.80 to a stone 3 paces on the branch, thence S. 10° E. 45.00 to a stone 31.00, and thence N. 65° E. 3.70 to a stone 3 paces, the beginning again returning to the first point and ending by due course of survey to the said James H. Clark, and myself by doing which is fully recorded in the Register Office of Greenville County, State of S. C., Day 45 of January, and hath this day

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
