Parker, at that price paid, that of land lying being located in the County of Greenville about 2.5 miles from the Capital House, along the Greenville Road, I am this day containing one eighth of an acre more or less, being the following particular, bounded beginning at a rock on stone 1800' E. 70 degrees to a stake 10 paces S. 1688 - 368 rods, thence going N. 1. bounded by roads of Joseph Parker, Mr. D. L. Mawhinney center, 40 feet,

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Joseph P. Parker, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Joseph P. Parker.

Heirs and Assigns, against me and myself, Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
