W. M. Alexander.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. M. Alexander, his heirs and assigns, all that certain tract of land, in and County and State, Greenville, containing fifty acres, one half acre more or less, lying and containing Wood tree on Saluda River, thence N. 75° E. 7.50 to a stone, thence S. 75° E. 2.75 to a stone, thence N. 10. 11. 3.50 to a stone, thence S. 14° E. 3.75 to a stone on the Greenville road, thence along said road to a stone at the cross roads, thence N. 75° E. 10. 26.75 to a stone, thence across the branch S. 32° W. 8.00 thence N. 41° W. 3.00 to a stone, thence S. 25° E. 14.10 to a birch tree on Saluda river, thence down said river to beginning. Bounding being the corner tract of land conveyed to me by R. F. Thompson, now deceased, on Dec 4, 1897, and our wife I gave a mortgage payable annually, to secure the number of one for one, recorded in Book C.C. of Mortgages on page 114, and to satisfy said mortgage left in full, this land is now unencumbered, reserving to myself the right to use and occupy said place. This Jan 18<sup>th</sup> 1905.

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
