W. Bush & J. H. Bush (Bush Brothers, partners), of the County and State of Virginia
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell and release unto the said A. D. Haughey, W. Bush, as well as his heirs, executors and administrators, living and
dying in the City and County of Greenville, in the block aforesaid bounded by North Street on the north, Sycamore Street
on the east, by Bush Brothers Store on the south, and the lot of Mrs. Bell Morgan on the west, and having
the following lines, angles and bounds, to wit: beginning at a stake on Sycamore Street and running thence
W. 19°, cross bearing 90°, feet to a stake corner of Avenue and North Street, thence N. 67° E. 66' 6 1/2 in. 65' feet
to a stake, thence S. 19° E. 66' 6 1/2 in. 68' 9 1/2 feet to a stake corner of Bush Brothers Store, thence S. 67°
E. 65' 6 1/2 feet to the beginning of lot, containing one eighth of an acre, more or less, being
above lot of land known as "the million dollar property," being dated 22nd of October 1904,
 further reviewed in Part of S. S. I. No. 36,

Partners).
Heirs and Assigns, against myself, and my wife, my children, my heirs, and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
