(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John L. Black All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situated on the north side of East Stone Avenue known as lot #4 (number four) on a plat showing a subdivision of the lands of the Mountain City Land and Improvement Co., lying between Main and Elizabeth streets and Stone Avenue in the City and County of Greenville as will more fully appear by reference to said plat recorded in Vol V.V. page 544 R.M.C. Office for said County. Said lot having the following metes & bounds to wit; beginning at a point on the North side of East Stone Avenue one hundred and sixty three and one third feet from Main Street, thence with said Ave. S. 73 E. 54.1/2 feet to an iron pin thence N. 17 E. 206.1/2 feet to Iron pin thence N. 73 W. 54.1/2 feet fifty four and one half to an Iron pin thence S. 17 W. 206.1/2 (two hundred Six and one half feet) to Iron pin at beginning corner this being the same lot of land conveyed to Charles L. Gilreath by the Mountain City Land and Improvement Co., on the 11th day of January 1901.
