Williams, all that piece of land situated in the County and State of Georgia near Woodside Cotton Mill containing Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty 7,830) sq. feet, moreover, the same hath such marks, bounds &c, as follows, viz: Beginning on the front line on forty foot Street and cor. 27 foot Street thence along latter N. 24° E. 70 feet to corner point whence N. 59° W. 105 feet to another point thence S. 18° W. 70 feet to another point hence along 40 foot street S. 59° E. 97 1/2 feet to the beginning, bounded by lot 1, 7, 8, of the cadastral map of Marian Brown, the same being set out by a survey of W.
