 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gandy & Turner, All that certain piece of land or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and City of Greenville, State aforesaid, at or near the East end of Court Street and the North side of said East Court Street. Containing Thirty nine poles (39 P) more or less, and having the following corners and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a stake corner N. W. on the North side of Court street and running thence N. 18° E. 1.24 3/4 cts. to a stake thence S. 72 1/2 E. 2.09 cts. to a stake thence S. 33 1/2 W. 3.1 ahs. thence N. 71 1/2 E. 1.76 cts. to the beginning corner. Being the same land conveyed to me by Hastings Howell by deed bearing date July 3rd 1870 and Recorded in the R. M. P. office for Greenville County in Vol. 41, at page 443, my grantees being at that time Milly White and as so expressed in said deed.
