(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Donaldson and his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece of land and tract of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid about two and one-half miles North East from Greenville Court House on the new Chick Springs road and having the following line: Beginning at the west side of the Chick Springs road, 130 feet beyond the stone and the back fence of the house of George A. Stone, thence N. 45° E. 30.36, to a W. O. Stump 3. X. O.; thence N. 29° 16' 50" to a stone 3X. N. on Chick Springs road, thence, with said road S. 78° 47' 46"; thence S. 28° 29' 36.45, thence S. 25° W. 2. 45, thence S. 14° W. 6. 60, to telephone pole, thence S. 1. 2/3° S. 60; thence S. 36° W. 2. 50, thence S. 64° W. 3. 38, thence S. 15° 46' E. 3. 00, to the beginning containing by estimation fourteen and two-thirds acres (4-2/3) more or less adjoining lands of myself, Stone, Donaldson, Barron and others, being part of a tract of land purchased by my late father, William Norwood, my Deed bearing date 18th April 1890, and now in Vol. V U 712, for a full and particular description of the parcel hereby envoys see plat—
