(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. J. Knebel, for the term of her natural life, all that certain piece of land, lot of land, situated, lying and being in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville fronting on Brown St and deeded to me by the Will of T. Hahn deceased. This lot is the property referred to in said will, to which reference is hereby made.

This property was conveyed in fee simple to my said mother on March 26, 1904, at which time I was a minor. Having attained my majority I now make this deed to her only a life estate in the said property. I hereby revoke the former Deed.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Mrs. J. Knebel, for the term of her natural life only. Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Mrs. J. Knebel, for the term of her natural life only. Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
