J. M. Grace and W. P. Grace.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. M. Grace and W. P. Grace, their heirs and assigns forever, all that piece of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina in Chick Spring Township about five miles from the City of Greenville, and having the following course and distance to wit, beginning at a 12o' broad stake, five feet wide from the center of the Southern Railway on south eastern side of about Avenue South 32, 46-8 (1/19) sixteenth hundred and nineteen feet to old corner there is R 81, S 04 (4.26) toward your house, subject to a road, five feet and four inches from the center of said Railroad, known as Thruway N 66.45 E (890) eighteen hundred and ninety feet to the beginning corner, containing 26 1/2 acres more or less; also all that other piece of land across the Railroad just with the above described land, and pointing on the dirt road from Greenville to Chick Spring two hundred feet, said line being parallel to that of the other, above tract running along said Railroad. Known as R 81, S 04, 4.26 one hundred and twenty five feet Thruway N 66.45 E two hundred feet Thruway One hundred and twenty five feet to the beginning corner containing seventy one and one hundredth part of an acre more or less both of said lots being part of the tract of Land conveyed to me by Franklin Morgan on the 5th day of March 1904 and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds page 479.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. M. Grace and W. P. Grace, their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. M. Grace and W. P. Grace, their Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
