P. McEllett, of the same place (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. P. McEllett or his assigns, the parcel of land lying and situated in the town of Townville of Johnsburg and Greenville lots 11 and 12 according to a general plan of a survey made by J. P. Williams of the town of Townville of Johnsburg, commencing at an iron post on lot No 7 on Main Street, Deposit Street to Rail Road Reservation on Deposit lot 11, running westwardly, J. P. McEllett, corner on one lot No 9 then with said lot to an iron post on Main Street hence up said Street, 60<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> feet to beginning corner on this lot now stands a two story brick building built by J. A. Cannon

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. P. McEllett, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I, J. P. McEllett, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. P. McEllett, his

Heirs and Assigns, against all and any Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
