KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A. B. Dower, of the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand and one hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. Hodges, of said City, County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. F. Hodges, all that piece of land or lot of land situate lying and being on the west side of Laurens Street in the City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid, and having the following lines and bounds to wit, beginning at the corner of Brick Stables now owned by T. G. Dower and formerly known as City Warehouse Car Line, thence with said line, along the wall of south side of said Brick Stables, N 74° W 100 feet to a line, known as the McDavid line, thence with said line S 16° W 100 feet more or less to line of lot now owned by Wm. H. Bates, thence with Wm. H. Bates line S 74° E 500 feet to Laurens Street at a point on said street 100 feet from McBee Avenue (McBates corner) and thence with said Laurens Street N 16° E 100 more or less to beginning corner and being a part of the lot conveyed to A. B. Dower & C. Cleveland by Annie P. Thurnton by deed bearing date May 29, A. D. 1890 and recorded in Rec. M. C. for said County in Book V. U. S. page 749 the interest therein of the said A. B. Dower, having subsequently been conveyed to me by Frank Hammond and Geller Miller Executor and Executrix of the last will and testament of said A. B. Dower deceased, my death bearing date April 29, 1897 and recorded Vol. 77 at page 53, TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. F. Hodges and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself to my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. F. Hodges and his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
