(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said General C. Sullivan All that piece of land or lot of land situated in the City of Greenville State aforesaid on the south side of McBee Avenue running at a stake 3x on McBee Avenue on corner of Earle, lot formerly known as 7th Street and running thence with his line S 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ W one hundred and ninety (90) feet to street or Alley twenty four wide, thence W 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ S fifty six feet (86) to line of Mrs Sarah C. Summons lot thence thence with line N 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ E one hundred and ninety two and a half (192 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet to a stake 3x on McBee Avenue, thence S 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ E Ninety (90) feet along McBee Avenue to the beginning thereof, containing Thirteen thousand eight hundred and Seventy (13870) square feet more or less, being the same property formerly owned by Joseph W. Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
