(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Thos. M. Goldsmith* all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, Greenville County, and State aforesaid, being lot No. 1, Containing Nineteen acres, by the same more or less, beginning at led. Oak 3x Thence N. 15° 41' 16.00 to a stone 3x, Thence due east 6.30 to a stone 3x, Thence N. 18° 41' 25.00 to a stone 3x, Thence S. 67° 37' 14.20 Thence 240 feet beginning corner. Being a portion of the Brashears' Anderson tract, Lot No. 2, joining the above being on creek waters of Reedy River. Beginning at the confluence of the standing springs branch thence down the rock to a small branch on left bank. Thence up the main branch of the branch 14 chs. to a sycamore 3x. Thence S. 22° 48' E. 4.83 to a stone 3x Thence N. 63° 15.12. to a stone on Dogwood line. Thence N. 16° W. 3.60 to a stone at bridge on branch. Thence down members of branch to a Maple 3x.
