Hammatt, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, within the City limits of Greenville, and lying west of Augusta Street, beginning at an iron post on the corner of James P. Hammatt's land and thirty-foot street between said land and Mrs. Margaret D. Williams; running thence N. 8 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 171 feet to an iron post on forty-foot street, between George and Williams; thence along the said street S. 86 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 454 feet to a thirty-foot street in rear of said property; thence S. 6 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 179 feet to an iron post at intersection of said thirty-foot street and Williams Street, thence with Williams Street N. 8 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 449 feet to the beginning corner being Brown's lot No. 7, containing  $\frac{4}{11}$  of an acre, more or less; lot No. 9, containing  $\frac{4}{11}$  of an acre more or less; lot No. 11, containing  $\frac{4}{11}$  of an acre more or less; and lot No. 12, containing  $\frac{4}{11}$  of an acre, more or less, according to survey of J.
