(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth E. Hunt,

All that tract piece or parcel of land conveyed to me by will of my deceased husband R. L. Jackson, situated and lying in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid and having the following aforesome courses and distances, on the East side of Rosine Creek, waters of Middle Tiger River, known as lot No. 2, in the partition of the Real Est. of Ad. H. Jackson, deceased, bounded by Lots No. 1 and 3 and lands of S. G. Pickens. Beginning on a stone on Rosine Creek corner of lot No 1 & 2 and running thence N. 87 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 52. 50 to a stone N. M. thence S. 32 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 66 to a stone N. M. thence S. 44. 00 to stone on Creek, thence up the meanderings of said creek to the beginning. Containing forty acres (40) more or less, it being the same tract heretofore belonging to my deceased husband R. L. Jackson and dead recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County in Book 13 B. S. page 274.
