North side of East Washington street and having the following Meters and bounds to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin, corner of building known as Duncan warehouse, on
Washington street exactly 130 feet from Main street, thence S. 69° E. 65 feet on Washington street,
thence N. 26° E. 65 feet to an iron pin on alley 15 feet wide, thence with said alley,
N. 69° W. 80 feet to an iron pin, corner of said Duncan warehouse building, thence S. 21° W. 65 feet
