 tract of Land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State  
of South Carolina containing Eighteen acres more or less, lying in Greenville Township  
about three miles from the City of Greenville between the Greenville and Columbia Rail  
Road, and the Anderson dirt road, and being the same tract of land conveyed to  
Said James C. Payne, by D. P. Herrell Master by deed bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of  
January, 1882, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, County of Said  
County, in Book 666, page 42, and bearing date March 6, 1896, and recorded in said office  
on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1896, also all that other piece of land tract of land lying and being in the County of Greenville  
situate on the Bamberg Bridge road about one and one half miles from the City of Greenville containing
