 (this receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. W. Hawkins, all that certain piece parcel and
tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of
South Carolina in Parish No. 10, Township on Water of Rudy River having the
following number and boundaries, to wit; Beginning at a stone 3x0.00 on corner of Maddy O'Davis
Land, running thence N. 42° 34' W. along line of J. Prioleau's border, had 700 chains to a stone
3x0.00 in N. 42° 34' W. along line of the 13th R. described and 700 ft. N. a stone 3x0.00,
along line of Fred Martin's land 20.000 ft. to stone 3x0.00 in N. 42° 34' along line of Maddy O'Davis
land 23.70 ch to the beginning corner, this being a portion of a tract of land, conveyed by Mrs. Mary
Orr Earle, guardian of M. B. Everett to James T. Davis, William T. Davis and Maddy O'Davis
by Deed bearing date February 8, 1897, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds
Conway, for Greenville County, South Carolina on March 17, 1897 in Deed Book
G. C. 10, page 737. The said James T. Davis and Maddy O'Davis having released unto me

 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
