(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Simpson, all that certain pieces of land or tract of land situate lying and being in said State and County of waters of Poplar Creek, containing one hundred & thirty seven acres more or less, having the following lines and bounds to wit: beginning at a Maple 3X0 W and running thence S 68.07 E 3.50 Ch to a Stake 3X0.20 m. at a bend in branch of stream with the meanderings of said branch to a Maple 3X0 in thence N 84.47 F. 10.25 ch to big dead White Oak 3X0 M. thence S 84.47 N. 39.00 Ch to a Poplar 3X0 more grove Creek thence N 17.21 F. 50 ch to a Poplar 3X0 M. thence N 70.0. 20.80 ch to a pile of Rock 1.8 3X0 W thence N 20.71 F. 24.60 ch to beginning corner, on a branch containing one hundred & thirty seven $\frac{1}{16}$ Acres more or less, and adjoining lands now or formerly belonging to Mrs Elizabeth Johnson D.
