county aforesaid, on the White Horse road, about three miles from the City of Greenville
and having the following metes and bounds to wit: beginning at a stone corner where
the White Horse road, and running with said road, 22. 10 chains to a stone corner thence
S. 8. E. W. 18. 56 chains to a stone corner thence S. 71. W. 10. 23. chains to a Red Oak, thence
S. 26. E. 22. 66 chains to a stone corner thence N. 72. 44 E. 1/4. 66 chains to the beginning
