(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leander L. Owens, all that piece of land and tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid and having the following lines and boundaries and distance to wit: Beginning on a white Oak tree running thence N 38 E to a chestnut tree S 70 E 13.50 ft abrand formerly at Spanish Oak then E 8.6.7.5 ch to a pine formerly a white Oak stump hence East 16.50 ft a chestnut tree S 9.8.15.5-0 ft a red Oak then E 8.3. W. 16 ft a chestnut oak then N 23 W. 4.0 ch to a hickory tree S. 8.6.7. W. 7.50 ft a hickory tree S. 7.0 W. 16 ch to the beginning and bounded by lands of R. B. Barton George Phillips Bree Barnes formerly Butler, Holland, Bowditch, and Rebecca Rector and being the same tract of land surveyed by Jessie Carter to Nathaniel Rector by Deed bearing date 22 day of September A.D. 1840 and recorded in the Office of Meuse Conveyances for Greenville County in Book, N.
