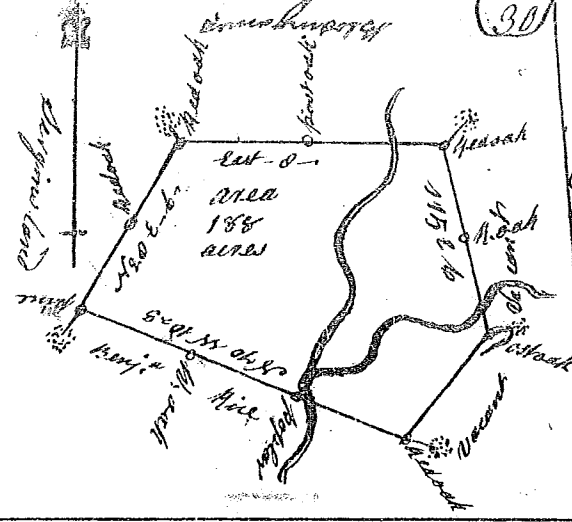


State of South Carolina

Deliv'd to Maj. Conner

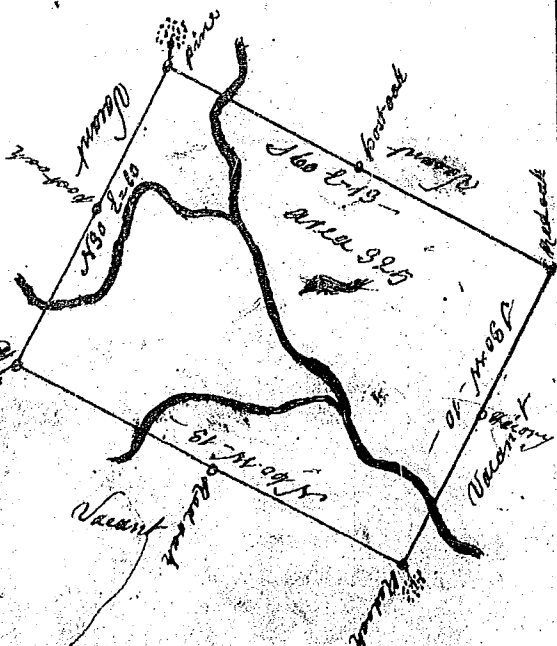
