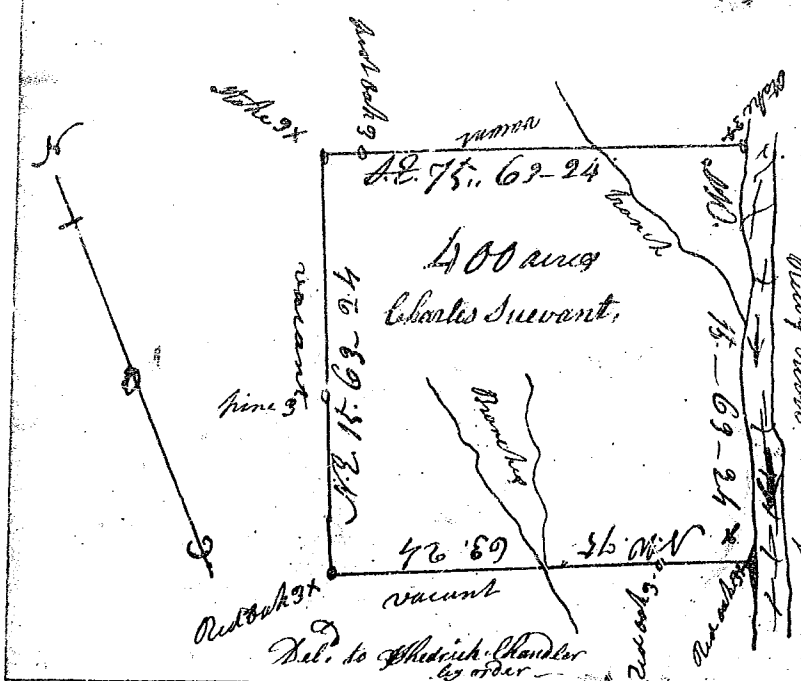


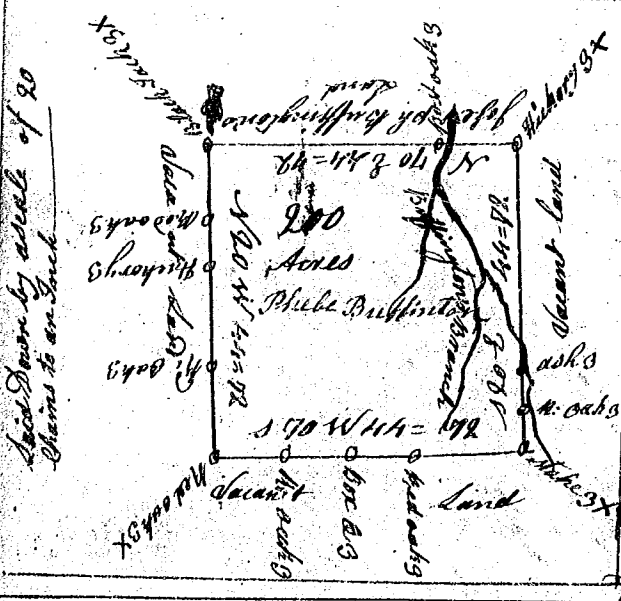
South Carolina

 De. to H. H. Seward



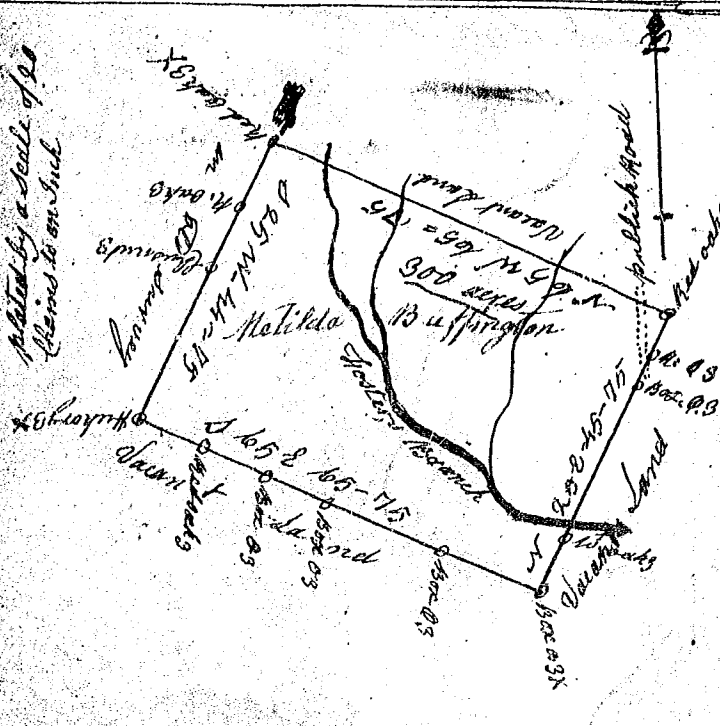

 Buffington a plantation or tract of land
 containing two hundred acres, situated lying
 and being in Ninety six District on a branch
 called Buffingtons branch, bounded North
 easterly by Joseph Buffingtons land, all
 other sides vacant land, I hath such other
 shape & marks as the above plan represents
 Surveyed 6th July 1784
 Recorded the 10th July 1784
 De. to Mrs. Buffington
