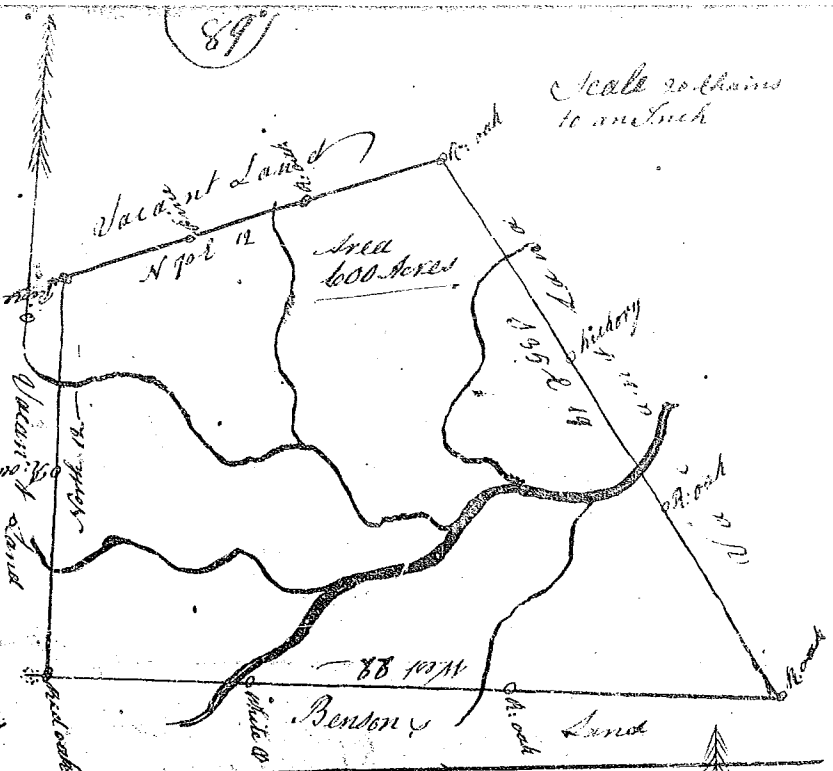


State of South Carolina 96 Dist.

Commissioner of Locations for the District of the north side of Saluda River I have Surveyed and laid out unto Merry Hall a Tract of Land containing 600 acres Situate Lying and Being above the Ancient Boundary line the waters of the Golden Grove Creek Bounded N.E. by Joseph Benson's Land on all other sides Vacant and had such shapes and marks as the above plat Represents

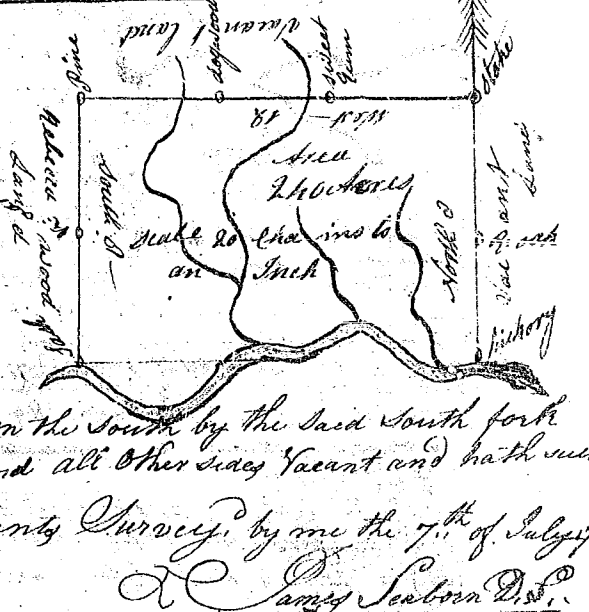

Pursuant to a warrant to me Directed by John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations for the District of North side Saluda River I have Surveyed and laid out unto Abel Pennington a Tract of land containing 240 acres Situate Lying and Being above the Ancient Boundary line on the south fork of Saluda river two miles below the Table Mountain Bounded on the south by the said south fork of Saluda and on the West by Rebecca Woods land all other sides Vacant and hath such shape and marks as the above plat Represents

Surveyed by me the 7th of July 1784
Recorded the 10th Day of August 1784



State of South Carolina 96 District above the Indian line

Pursuant to a warrant from Under hand and seal of John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations on the North side of Saluda river I have Admeasured and laid out unto John Nicoll a plantation or tract of land containing 500 acres on a branch of Sygar River called Mush Creek on both sides of said Creek Bounding on every side by Vacant Land and hath such other shape and marks as the above plat Represents Said Warrant Bearing date Twenty first day of May 1784 and in the eighth year of American Independency Given under my hand this 26th day of May 1784
