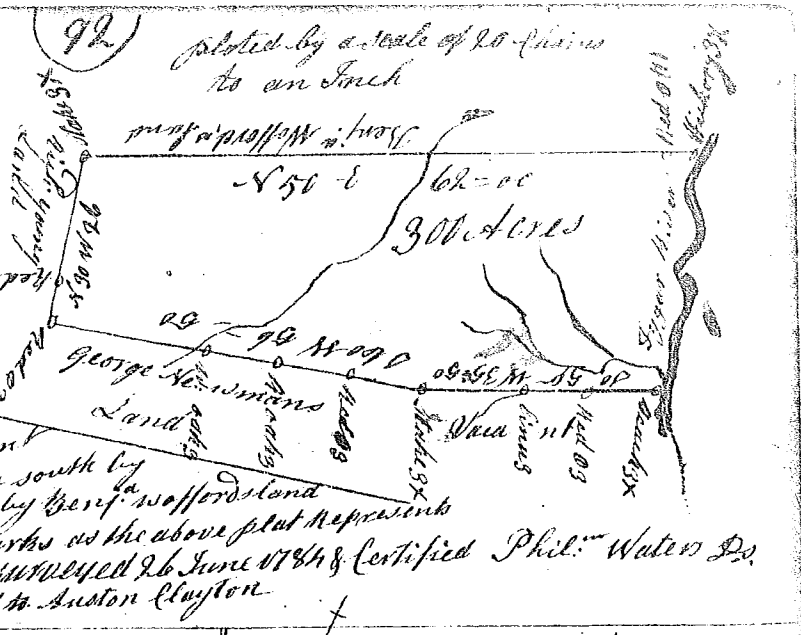


State of South Carolina 96 District

Commissioner of Locations for the Northside of Saluda River bearing date 7th June 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto Austin Clayton tract of Land containing three hundred Acres on the south side of Sygar River bounded to the North by said River Eastwardly by Vacant Land and George Forman's Land to the south by Michl. Johnson's Land and to the west by the above plat Represents and hath such other Shape and Marks as the above plat Represents

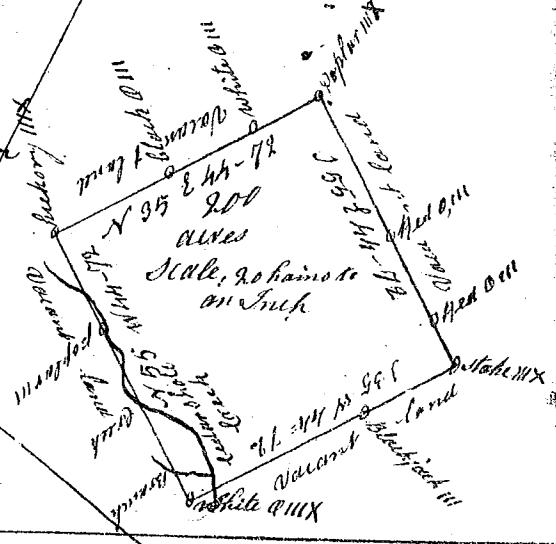

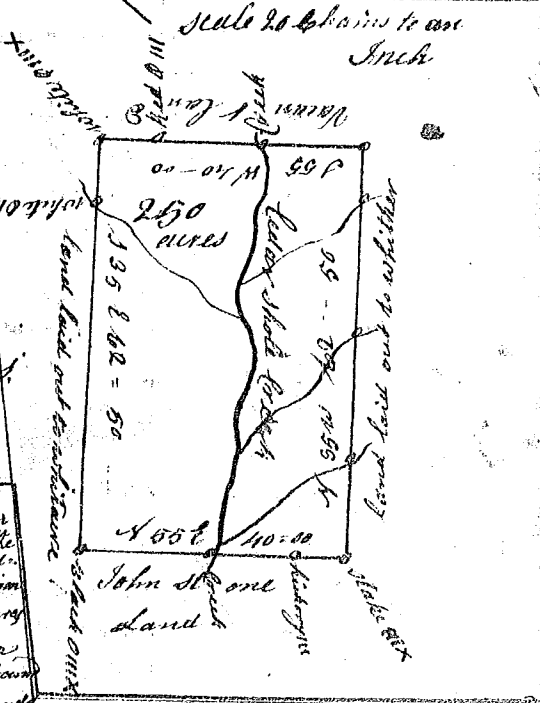

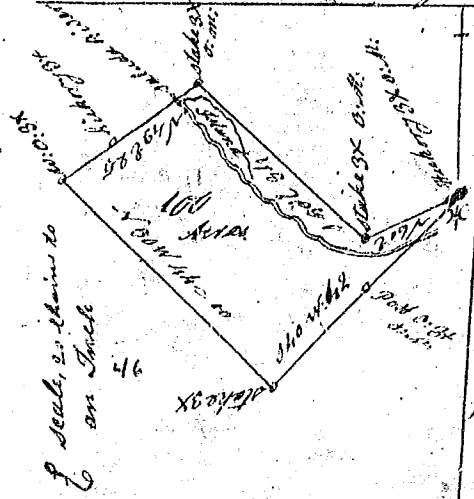

South Carolina Pursuant to a precept from John Brewer Esq. (Deft. Surveyor Genl) Dated the 7th day of August 1770, I have admeasured and laid out unto William Lefey a tract of one hundred acres of Land Situat in 96 District on the N.W. side of Saluda River bounding N.W. on said River & West on land formerly held by Jefe Moore N.C. on lands Claimed by one Chisterlin and hath such Shape and marks as the above Plat Represents
