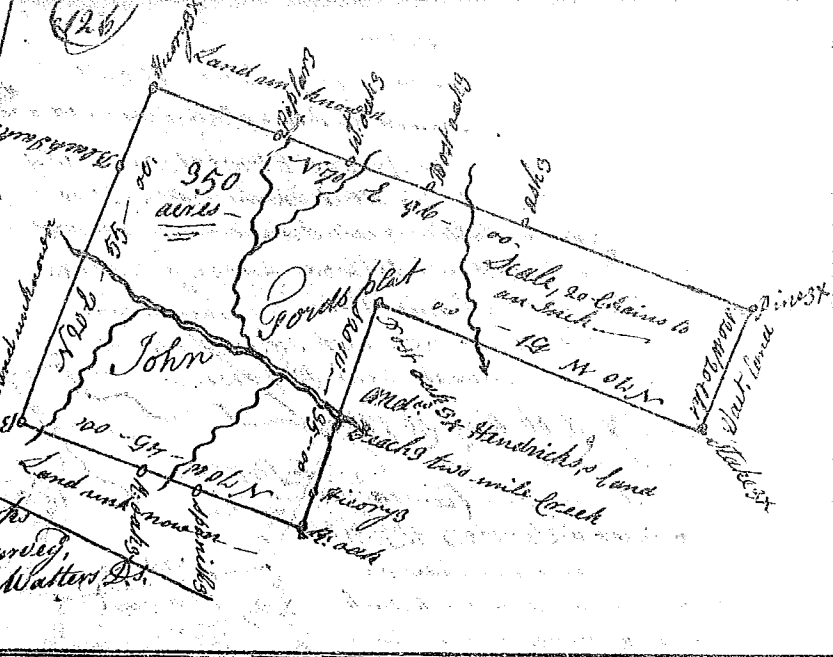
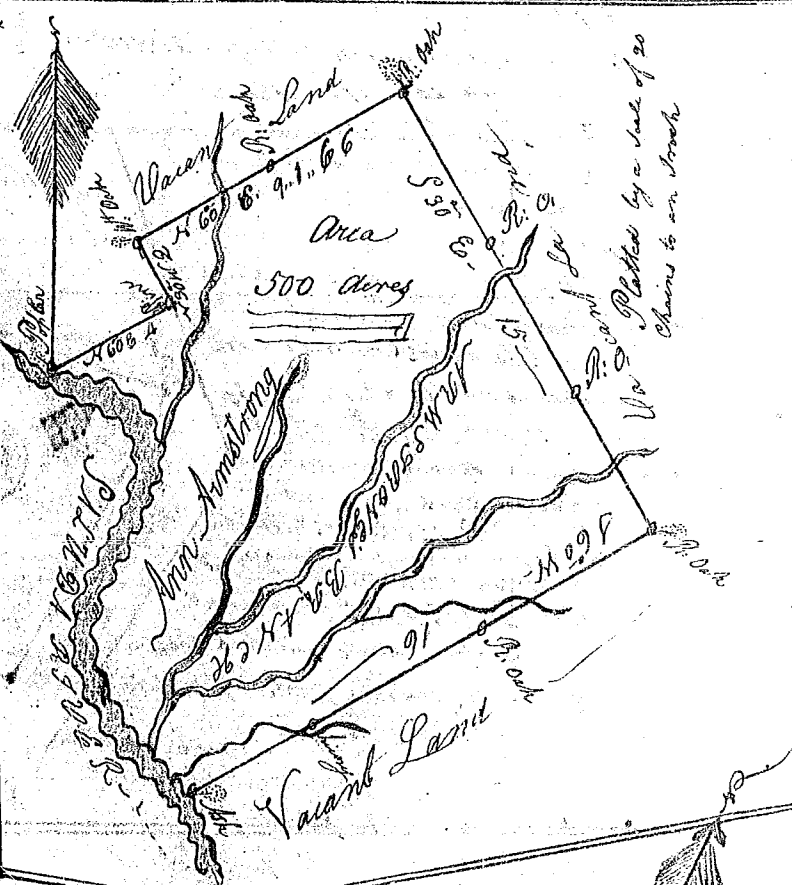

Westwardly by lines the owners unknown westwardly and Andrew Hendricks's land all other sides Vacant and shall such other shape and Markes as the annexed Plat Represents, Surveyed the 17th July 1784 — Phil. Watters D. S.
