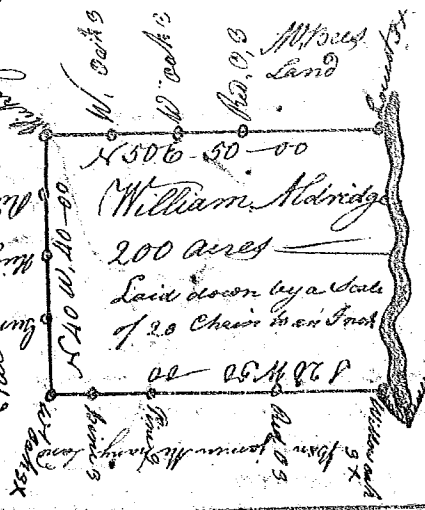
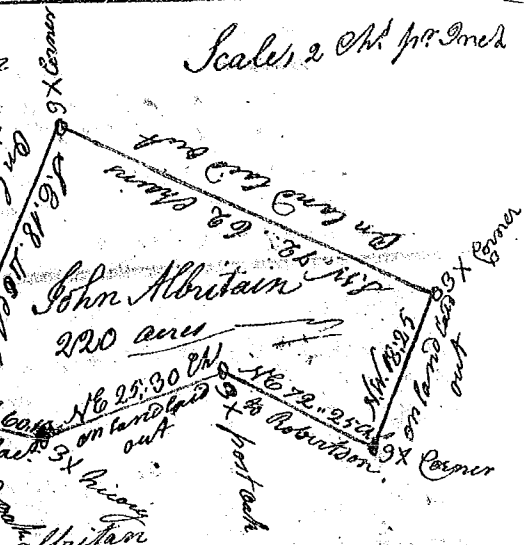

 and marks as the Annexed plat Represents
 Surveyed the 11 August 1784 D. Hopkins
 Recorded the 30 Sept. 1784 (Delivered to J. Albritain)

 (dated the 14 June 1784) I have ad-
 measured & laid out unto James
 Crooks a tract of land containing
 five hundred & fifty acres on Browns
 creek below the Indian Boundary
 in Ninety Six District Bounded
 S. on Bounty land E. on Thomas Deans
 Land N. on John Atways Land S.E. on John
 McClintock's Land. S.W. on Survey Land
 and hath such shape and marks
 as the annexed plat Represents
 Surveyed the 16 June 1784 D. Thomas
 Recorded the 5 day of Oct. 1784 (Deliv. to J. Crooks)
