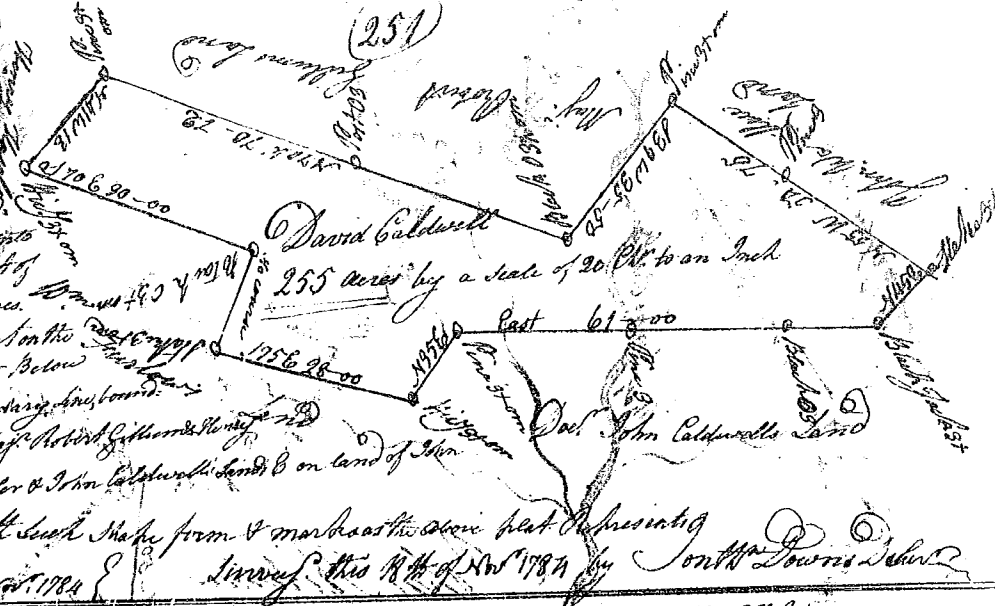


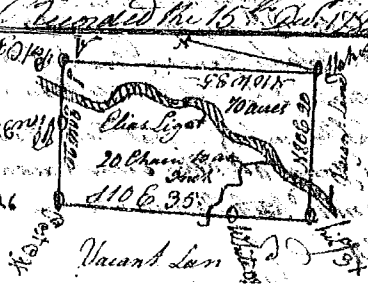
State of Carolina
