

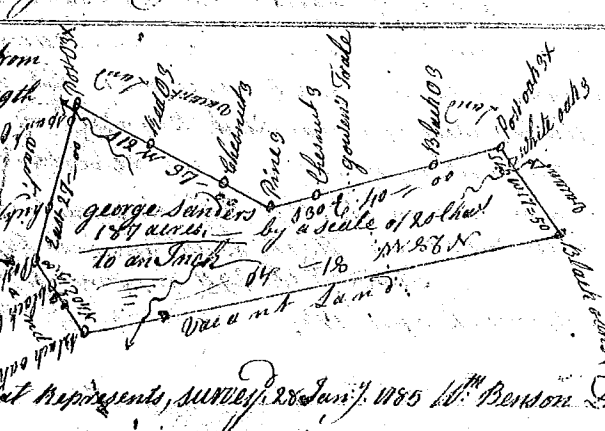
State of South Carolina.
