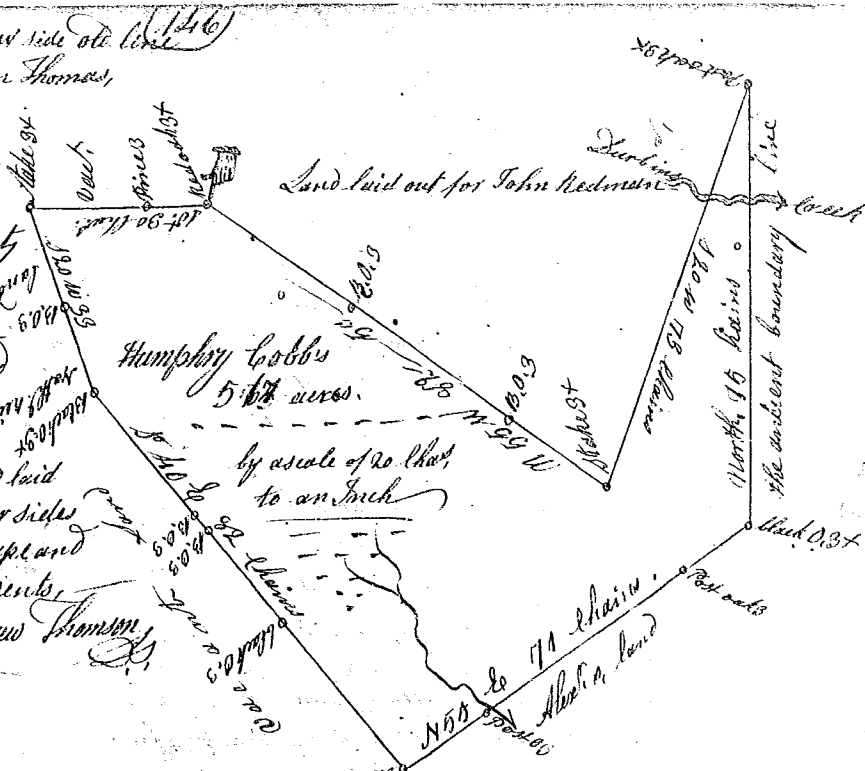
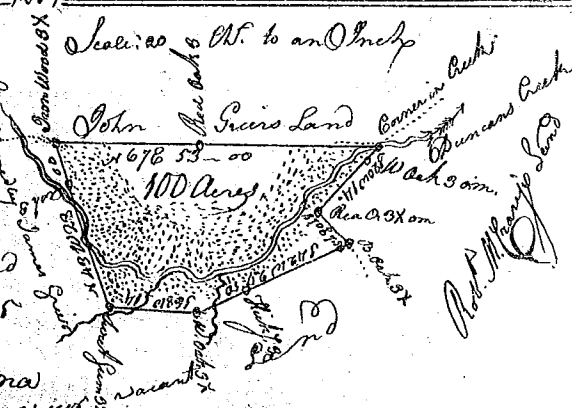


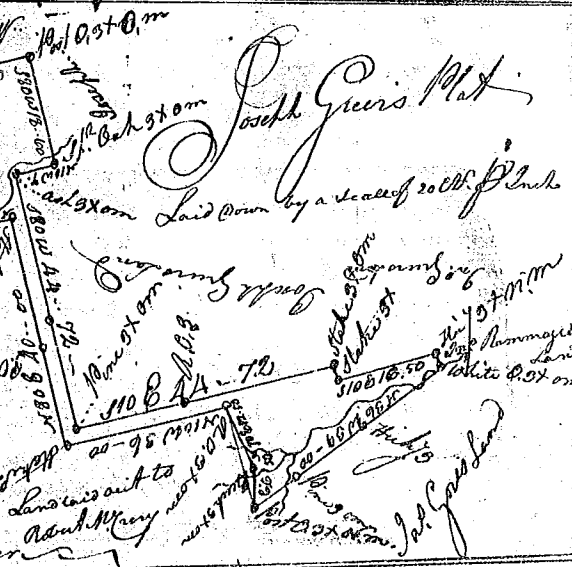
State of S^c Carolina 96 District W side old line (1746)
 Pursuant to warrant from John Thomas, Commissioner of locations, Dated the 3^d day of April 1785. I have admeasured and laid out unto Humphrey Cobb a tract of land containing five hundred and sixty seven acres, lying on the small branches of Durbin's Creek, waters of Enore River, bounded N by land surveyed for Nathaniel Reid & by the ancient boundary line NW by land laid out to John Alexander Meekman, S & E by land laid out for one Alexander, all other sides vacant land, and hath such shape and marks as the above plat represents.

 Recorded the 16th June 1785.
