

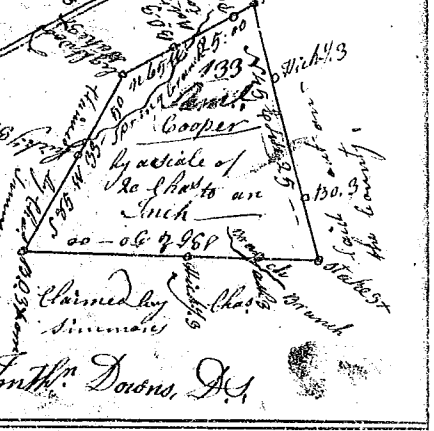

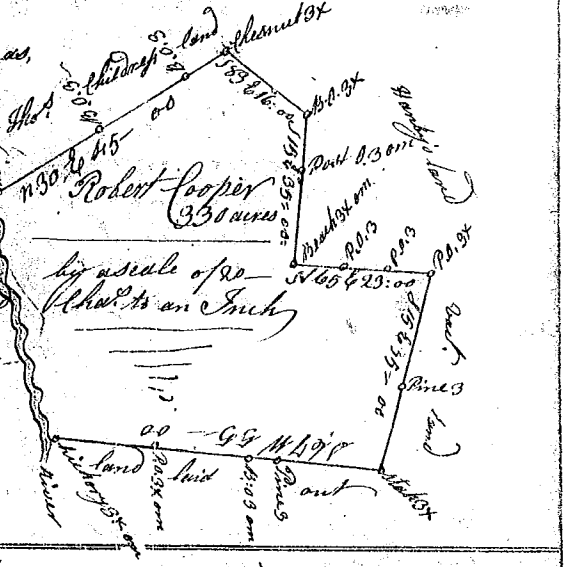

 little river, called Spring branch N<sup>e</sup> & S<sup>e</sup> on Capt Charles Simmons  
 land N<sup>w</sup> on land of Robt Cooper and land laid out on the county  
 below the ancient boundary line, and hath such shape and marks
