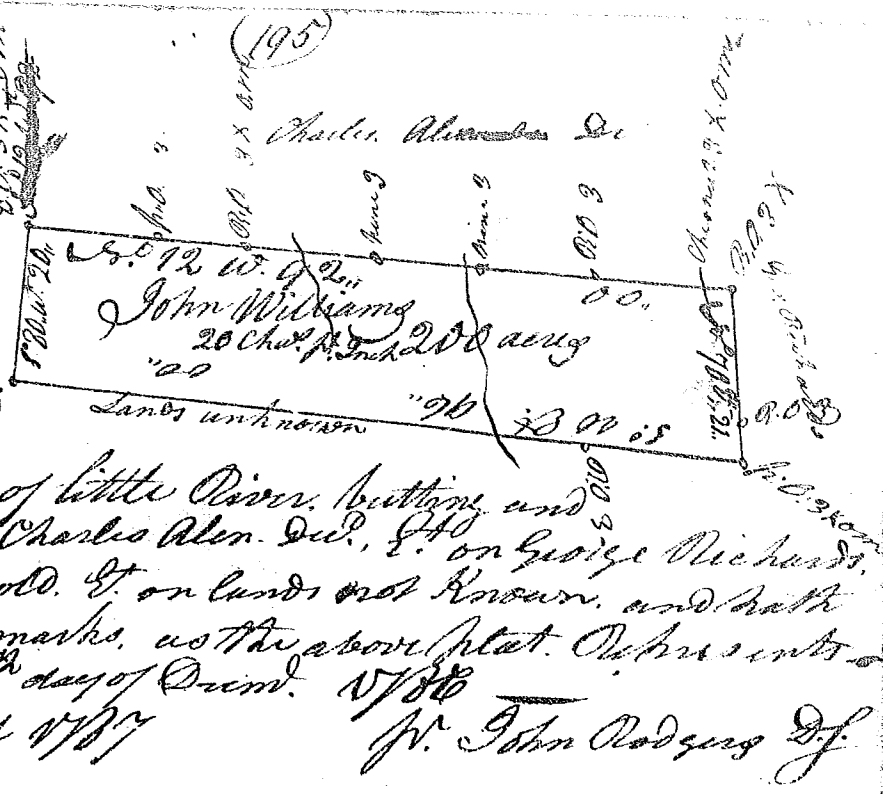


Laurens County
