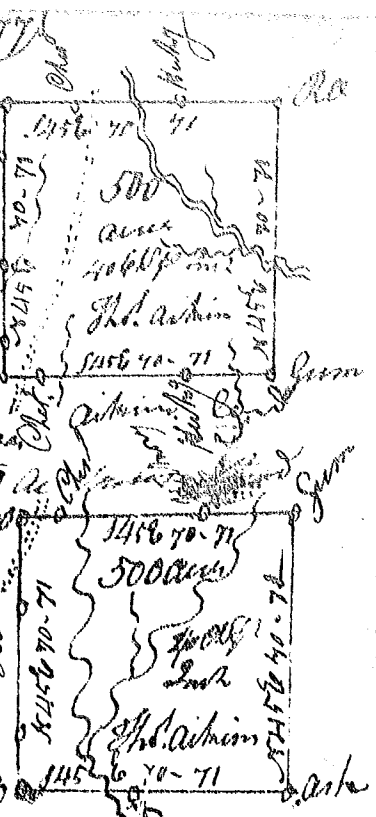


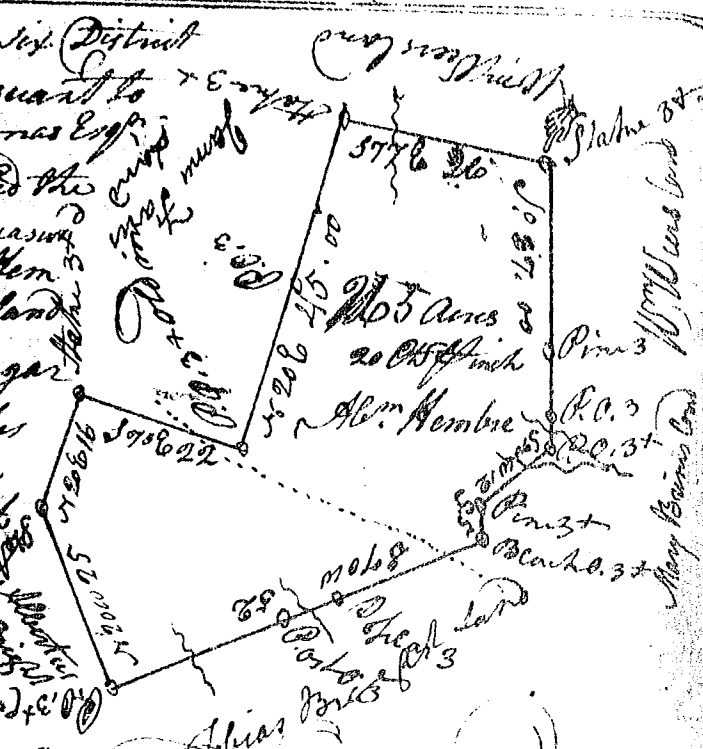

Dated the 14 Nov. 1787, I have admeasured and laid out unto Abraham Hembree a tract of 265 Acres of land Situate on the n. side of Sugar River, on the small branches of Dutchmans Creek by Cain Creek of Sugar River; of both such stake marks, Buttys and bounding as the above filed Plan represents Survey the 10 Nov. 1787
